The Purple Rose Theatre Company Announces Summer Youth Classes

Registrations Now Being Taken For Both Kid Purple and Teen Intensive

This summer, the PRTC offers two classes for students under 18 years old: Kid Purple and Teen Intensive. Taught by PRTC Resident Artist Michelle Mountain, both classes feature new curriculum and a live showcase performance for friends and family.

Kid Purple, a two-week day camp for children ages 8 to 12, is scheduled for Mondays through Fridays, June 18-29. Class will be held from 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM at the PRTC's rehearsal space in the Chelsea Center for the Arts. Kid Purple encourages children to explore the production process from start to finish. Through improvisation games and acting exercises, students create a short play, design the set and props, and perform the finished product on the final day of class. The class incorporates theatre games with visual art and features collaboration with professional designers, actors and playwright. Cost for the class is \$375.

Teen Intensive, designed for students ages 13 to 18, will meet Monday through Saturday from July 9-14; class will be held from 11:00 AM to 4:00 PM at the Chelsea Center for the Arts. Teen Intensive focuses on how to get a role and give the best performance. Students receive training in audition techniques, voice and movement work, and character development; they will gain hands-on experience in monologue and scene performance. Students must come to class with a memorized, one-minute comic monologue from a published play. Cost for the class is \$185.

Registration is available immediately by calling the PRTC administration office at (734) 433-PRTC (7782); hours are Mondays through Fridays from 10:00 AM until 5:00 PM. Registrations are accepted on a pre-paid first-come, first-serve basis; full payment is required to register.
