

Reopening was much more complex and difficult than most people realize. As a professional theater, we have an actor's union that sets safety protocols that must be followed for the artists, crew, and patron's safety. Other requirements involved upgrading our HVAC system and hiring a full time COVID-19 Safety Manager. We have poured hundreds of hours and thousands of dollars into deep cleaning, sanitizing, and improving our systems and protocols to keep everyone safe.

PLAYWRIGHT



JEFFRY CHASTANG (Playwright) is a Michiganbased playwright and screenwriter. Jeffry received his MFA in Playwriting from Ohio University. He was commissioned by the Alabama Shakespeare Festival to write a play marking the sesquicentennial of the Civil War. The resulting play, Blood Divided, received a New Play Award from the Edgerton Foundation. Jeffry's play, Dauphin Island, also received a New Play Award from the Edgerton Foundation and reached semi-finalist status with the O'Neill National Playwrights Conference. Dauphin Island received its world premiere at the Alabama Shakespeare Festival and was also produced by the Detroit Repertory Theatre and the Passage Theatre in Trenton, NJ. Jeffry's screenplay of Dauphin Island reached semi-finalist status in the 2021 Cynosure Screenwriting Competition. He was recently commissioned to write a play as part of the 2021-2022 Michigan chapter of the Vagrancy Theatre Writers' Group. Jeffry is making his Purple Rose Theatre debut with his latest work, this world premiere production of, Under Ceege.
