Position Description

This person reports to the Director of Donor Engagement and works with other staff and board members across the organization to further PRTC's mission and fundraising goals.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

The Donor Services Associate works to keeps in regular contact with current donors, supports general operating fund campaigns and works closely with staff and the volunteers supporting the PRTC fundraising program as well as:

- Oversees event planning and works closely with special event volunteers.
- Plans and manages direct mail appeals.
- Maintains the accuracy and integrity of the PRTC database, guides gift processing and other data management tasks, and ensures that all information is kept current.
- Prepares and mails donor and donor prospect communications, including stewardship communications, solicitations, and acknowledgements.
- Supports grant writing with research, data collection, fact checking, and proofreading.
- Performs basic administrative duties such as filing, data entry and more.
