Our first year of producing new plays was as up and down as the Blue Streak at Cedar Point. People weren't coming, the local talent was sporadic, I was financially tapped out, and fundraising could be summed up in a remark made by an early board member who said, "Let's see if you're still here in six months."

Up against it, I sat down and tried to think of what I could write that might entice an audience in this corner of the country to buy a ticket. I knew if we were to have any chance of surviving to see the Summer, I'd have to write a hit. Easy to say, hard to do. And then it hit me. Funny is universal. Funny feels good. Funny also sells tickets.

My theatrical Hail Mary was a wild comedy about a dinner party for the boss where everything goes wrong. Set in Macomb County, *The Tropical Pickle* opened in May, 1992. We were hoping to get to June. The play ran until Labor Day.

Comedy saved us.

With a stellar cast and a first rate design team that has piled on their own comedic inspirations, this remount of *Diva Royale* - back by public demand - is teed up to provide what so many of you have told us you not only want, but need. A good laugh.

Funny transcends politics, polarization and fear of the future. You're not here to watch the news. You want joy, here it is. You want to let yourself go, allow us. You want to feel good again, we're happy to help.

So buckle up. Here come the Divas.
