


CAST OF CHARACTERS

DAVID MACGREGOR (Playwright) The Antichrist Cometh is David's tenth production at The Purple Rose Theatre. Previous shows include: The Late Great Henry Boyle (2006), Vino Veritas (2008), Gravity (2010), Consider the Oyster (2011), Just Desserts (2014), Vino Veritas (2017), Sherlock Holmes and the Adventure of the Elusive Ear (2018), Sherlock Holmes and the Adventure of the Fallen Soufflé (2019), and Sherlock Holmes and the Adventure of the Ghost Machine (2022). His plays have been performed from New York to Tasmania, and his work has been published by Dramatic Publishing, Playscripts, Smith & Kraus, Applause, Heuer Publishing, and Theatrical Rights Worldwide (TRW).

David adapted his dark comedy, *Vino Veritas*, for the silver screen, and it stars Carrie Preston (Emmy-winner for "The Good Wife"). Several of his short plays have also been made into films. He also adapted all three of his Sherlock Holmes plays into novels for Orange Pip Books, and those novels have been translated into Italian by Mondadori Publishing. His two-volume nonfiction book, *Sherlock Holmes: The Hero with a Thousand Faces*, was published in 2021 by Londonbased MX Publishing. David teaches writing at Wayne State University in Detroit, is a member of the Dramatists Guild, and is inordinately fond of cheese and terriers.

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














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




The Sustainable Modern Homestead

The Sustainable Modern Homestead started with a set of fundamental ideas: an

energy-efficient, earth-friendly home that melds interior and exterior, inviting open space into the home environment without sacrificing privacy, and that engages the surrounding landscape for its beauty, as well as its natural warmth and cooling potential.



Through a series of early schematic massing and plan review sessions, Giraffe designers and the homeowners were able to develop a spatial arrangement that was uniquely suited to their family, while embracing a series of sustainable features they are passionate about. Deep roof overhangs and a careful arrangement of south facing windows create passive solar heating potential.

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


